Kreative Kids

CLF's Kreative Kids Therapeutic Arts provides a non-threatening creative outlet for school-age patients (and siblings) to explore feelings and form friendships with others their own age that are/were going through similar experiences. This program is open to patients of all ages and their immediate family.

Holiday Toys Program

To make the December holidays brighter, CLF distributes toys and gifts to children and teenagers whose families are affected by leukemia and related blood disorders. This program is for child patients and their siblings and the children of adult patients.

Ticket Donation Program

CLF provides donated tickets to events (sporting events, concerts, day passes, movie theaters, etc.) to our patients and families.



Stepping Stones

All newly registered families receive *Stepping Stones*, a 150-page kit filled with facts, interactive exercises, and referrals that empower families with the information they need to gain answers to their illness-related questions.

Family Recreation Events

CLF has several recreation events each year all over the State. Patients and families can enjoy events such as bowling, ice skating, horseback riding, apple orchards, and so much more!
