Children's Leukemia Foundation of Michigan to Award \$50,680 to Hole-In-One Winner

TROY, Mich. – On Wednesday, August 28, 2013 Grosse Pointe Park resident, Mark Rieth will receive an Infinity XJ35 valued at \$50,680 from the Children's Leukemia Foundation of Michigan. Rieth won the grand prize at the sixth annual Gray's Reef Golf Classic charity outing hosted by Children's Leukemia Foundation of Michigan on June 17, 2013.

During the charity outing, Rieth shot a 165 yard hole-in-one from the seventeenth tee on the Old Course at Indianwood Golf and Country Club, becoming the outing's first ever hole-in-one winner. Rieth was accompanied on the course with teammates Geoff Tischbein and John Kennedy who also witnessed this once in a lifetime experience. Rieth will be presented with his winnings by members of the Children's Leukemia Foundation of Michigan staff and Gray's Reef Golf Classic committee in a formal check presentation at Indianwood Golf Course. The check presentation will begin at 10:00 AM.
